



- it is now official. The New York State practical exam in Ophthalmic Dispensing has become virtual and those candidates who meet the education department's rules can take the exam at different test sites in New York State at times and locations specified by the State Education Department of the Professions in New York State.
- An Oregon optical owner took matters into his own hands. James and Dr. Laura Armstrong had a goal to find and retain qualified opticians. in 2016 James reached out to Portland Community College and pitched the formation of an ABO training program. it took time for pieces to come together, and the program started in the year 2020 and will help to expand the level of proper skill and training for the field.
