

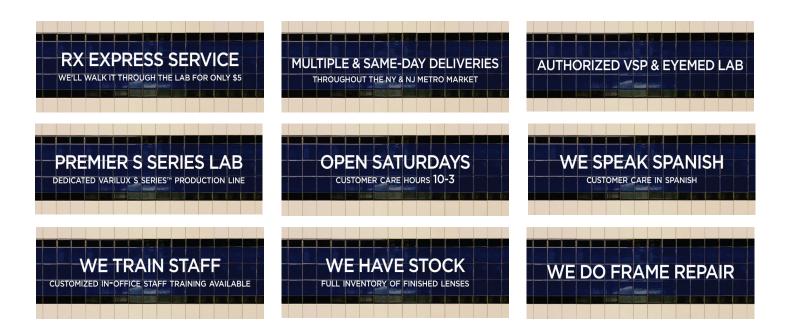

New Technology

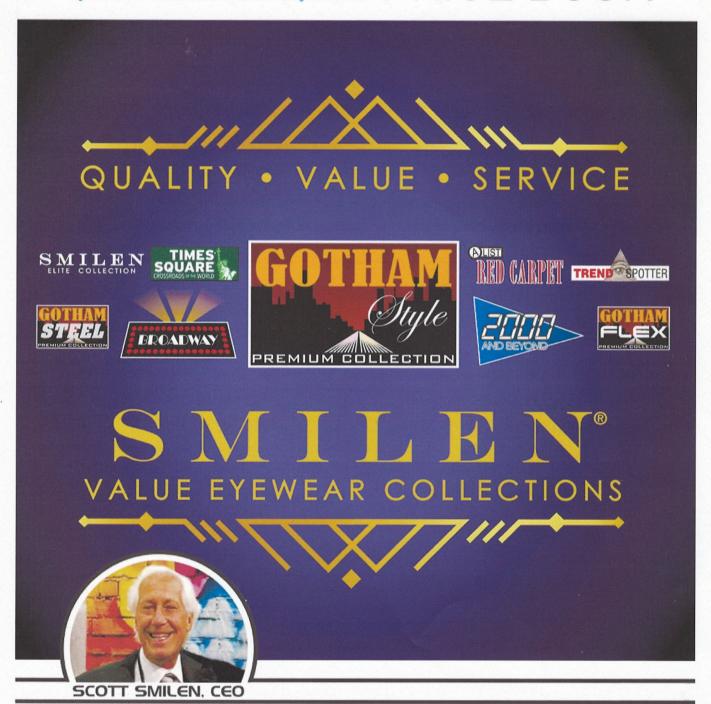
